Now, two Havahart live traps are located along the eastern and western edges of the field, right by the clusters of rocks that thousands of woodchucks call home. Five woodchucks were captured and released (very far away) this week. We will continue with this method until no traces of woodchucks remain. Some crops affected by the nasty marmots include lettuce, edamame, green beans, and brussel sprouts.

Other than battling the woodchucks, life has been pretty normal around the farm. This is a busy time of year, it seems all we do is pick, pick, pick. (and grin, grin, grin). Garlic was pulled this weekend and is drying in the barn. This year's crop is beautiful! We are looking forward to sharing it with you!
